

Accessing the Civics Test

- **Students must pass with 35/50 items correct – 70%.**
- **Students may take the test as many times as necessary.**
- **Students can take the test at any time from 8th grade through 12th grade, but must have received 70% or higher by graduation in order to receive a diploma.**
- **Students must take the Civics Test in the school under the supervision of a Weber School District employee (teacher, aide, administrator, etc.).**
- **Results will automatically flow through into the graduation screen in MyStudent.**
